

## **Overview of the Senior Service Award**

To apply for the Senior Service Award, the following criteria must be met:

- Must be a member of a chapter or emerging chapter who has shown outstanding scholarship, leadership, character, and service.
- Must be a senior graduating from an undergraduate degree program during the 2023-2024 academic school year.
- Seniors who elect alumna status before graduating are ineligible to apply; seniors who elect special status may still be eligible to apply.
- Must have a letter of recommendation submitted on their behalf by any alumnae member of their advisory board.
- Must also be reviewed and officially nominated by their Advisory Board.

## **Background & Overview of Instructions**

Theta Phi Alpha's Senior Service Award is the highest award granted to a collegiate member. This national award is presented in recognition of a senior collegiate member whose scholarship, leadership, character, and service to the Fraternity and school has been outstanding during their years as a collegian. The award is presented during the Founders' Day Ceremony. Additional information, applications, and alumnae forms can be found on the <u>Senior Service Award Information Page</u>.

The Senior Service Award <u>application</u> and <u>photo and release</u> form must be submitted by the applicant, no later than November 1. Once the <u>application</u> is submitted, the applicant and their Chapter Advisor (or the Chapter's Conference Manager) will receive a copy of the application.

The applicant indicates on their <u>application</u> form, the alumna member from their chapter's advisory board who has been asked to submit the <u>recommendation form</u> for the applicant. A copy of the application is automatically sent to this alumna advisor. The <u>recommendation form</u> can be submitted before or after the application is submitted, but it must be completed no later than November 30.

The alumna members of the Advisory Board are then required to review all applications and complete the CAB <u>Nomination Form</u>. Up to two candidates may be nominated to the Board of Trustees for consideration by November 30. The review process and the names of the candidates nominated are to remain confidential. *If there are no applicants, advisors do not need to complete this form*.
