BAY VILLAGE, Ohio – With great sadness, the Grand Council of Theta Phi Alpha recently voted to indefinitely suspend the charter of the Delta Iota Chapter at New Jersey City University in Jersey City, New Jersey.

The Delta Iota Chapter was originally chartered in 2017 and since then they've received dedicated support from Fraternity volunteers and staff. Challenges in achieving continued successful membership recruitment results have hindered the ability of the chapter to provide the enriching membership experience that our legacy dictates.

“This is among the most difficult decisions we face as Grand Council members,” said National President Tracey Liphardt. “Indefinitely suspending a chapter’s charter is never easy but we look forward to continuing our lifelong sisterhood with the Delta Iota Chapter members through their membership as alumnae.”

The Delta Iota Chapter will forever remain a valued part of the Theta Phi Alpha sisterhood. Collegiate members of the Delta Iota Chapter will transition to alumnae members of Theta Phi Alpha and will continue to experience a lifetime of sisterhood along with the privileges of being a lifelong member of Theta Phi Alpha.
