## A Year in Review

Dear Sisters,

As we close the books for the Foundation's 2017-18 fiscal year, we celebrate the successes that we have reached, and we look towards even bigger goals for the future. Theta Phi Alpha Foundation made great strides in supporting the scholarship, philanthropic, educational, and leadership interests of Theta Phi Alpha sisters. We continued to grant funding to Theta Phi Alpha's Leadership Consultants, who give presentations while on-site at chapters and emerging chapters. We also fund Officer Leadership Training sessions held at three sites nationwide to educate our chapter leaders. Our support of Camp Friendship and Glenmary continues, along with supporting philanthropic efforts related to homelessness under the banner *The House that Theta Phi Alpha Built*. We also provided relief to sisters impacted by natural disasters. Last, but certainly not least, we remain true to our original purpose of providing scholarships to sisters. We presented \$20,000 in scholarships and provided for two collegiate

sisters to attend Undergraduate Interfraternity Institute (UIFI). These achievements are possible because of the generosity of donors who set record levels of giving this year.

We thank Jennifer Lando, AE, and Christine Kay O'Brien, K, for their service as Directors, along with Susan Grau Lee, Σ, who served on the Foundation as National President of Theta Phi Alpha. We welcome new National President, Tracey Liphardt, AN, as a Director.

This year saw continued growth in the number of Sustaining Sisters and 1912 Society members and increased participation in the Giving Tuesday campaign. Our communication efforts were strengthened to increase visibility, transparency, and accountability.

We updated our White Rose Garden program – no longer just for convention, they are available year-round to send to sisters for birthdays, graduations, initiations, or just because! At Convention, we announced Mission Glenmary – an endowment to ensure that Theta

Phi Alpha's first philanthropy is supported in perpetuity.

I close this letter with the acknowledgement of the very great loss of our sister and friend, Sue Check, AΞ, who joined the eternal chapter in October. Sue was the voice and heart of the Foundation at National Office and she is profoundly missed, both on a business and personal level. Many sisters donated to the Foundation in Sue's memory and we are thrilled to announce that, in conjunction with her family's wishes, the Foundation has allocated those donations towards Mission Glenmary, now known as the ***Susan Kugler Check Endowment for Glenmary***. RIP Sue.

## Scholarship Spotlight

In Pittsburgh, a record 14 scholarships totaling \$21,000 were announced at the Foundation Breakfast during the 52<sup>nd</sup> National Convention.

Four categories of funds are used to provide scholarships to the recipients: endowments, restricted funds, sponsorships, and unrestricted funds. (See p. 4 for more details.)

Molly Smith, Beta Psi, learned that she had received the Amelia McSweeney Scholarship in a text from her chapter president, Mary Levine, who attended the breakfast. Mary was proud and excited to hear her chapter sister's name.

Molly is a senior at Merrimack College in North Andover, Massachusetts, majoring in psychology with a minor in health science graduating in May 2019. After working for a year, she plans to pursue a Master's degree in occupational therapy.

Molly's career goal is to work with children who have autism or other sensory processing issues. Her path to her vocation started at the age of one. Her family owns a gymnastics training facility. She pursued a path to coaching gymnastics, starting training for it at the age of 12. As a coach, Molly worked with several students who were autistic or had other communication disorders. Molly felt a special connection to these students and enjoyed working with them. Not only does she teach them gymnastics, but also social skills and balance. As a volunteer in the Healthy Balance Program at nearby high schools, Molly leads students in the

special needs classes by giving them physical activities to stay healthy.

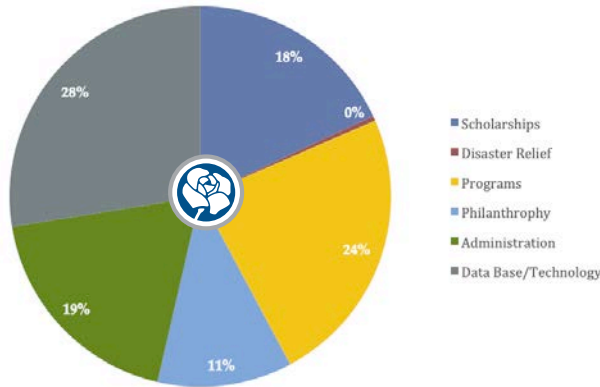
Molly applied for the scholarship because she "thought it was special to apply for a Theta Phi Alpha scholarship since not everyone can." As the second of five children, Molly's hope is that the scholarship will relieve some of the financial burden on her parents - whose support she plans to repay in the future.

In addition to her coursework, Molly works both as a coach and a nanny. She also volunteers with the Young Athletes Program of Special Olympics, teaching new sports to children aged two to eight years old.

As Beta Psi's philanthropy chair, Molly has organized a fundraiser for Theta Phi Alpha Foundation, and worked with her chapter to support The House that Theta Phi Alpha Built. Beta Psi holds a Donation Day at the end of the semester to collect clothes, coats, blankets, and supplies. Molly helped her chapter to select Daybreak Shelter in nearby Lawrence, where the collegians are able to distribute the items directly to those in need.

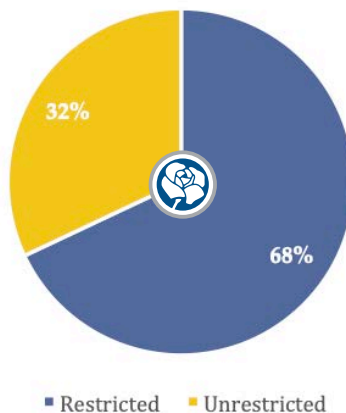

Our 2018 fiscal year results include record contributions, exceeding \$100,000 in donations for the first time. The Foundation continues our technology commitment with Theta Phi Alpha Fraternity to provide improved resources to members. The database, member portal, and officer portal continue to evolve, offering additional functionality. Individual members can access their Foundation donation history in the Member Portal (see p. 7 for access information).

Your generous contributions help us to provide academic and UIFI scholarships, support educational and development programs, and leadership consultants. Administration includes mailings, National Office resources, articles in *The Compass*, supplies, insurance, and accounting fees.

In 2018, the Foundation's financial positions strengthened. Total assets have increased to \$323,007. The majority of these funds (77%) are restricted for use in accordance with donors' wishes, such as toward scholarships, leadership education, and our national philanthropies.

## National Convention 2018

### Speakers

Theta Phi Alpha Foundation sponsored the Siena Medal Recipient and two other speakers at the National Convention. Siena Medalist Ginny Carroll of Circle of Sisterhood explained the global importance of education of girls and women. Karyn Nishimura Sneath and Jessica Pettitt provided leadership education.

### Philanthropy

Convention attendees were joined by Father Dominic Duggins, of Glenmary Home Missioners, who thanked Theta Phi Alpha for our generous support throughout the years. He was surprised to learn that the Foundation has established a *Mission Glenmary* Endowment to ensure contributions in perpetuity to Theta Phi Alpha's original national philanthropy.

Heidi Stephens represented Camp Friendship, providing sisters with a powerful presentation on the impact the Camp has on the children who attend. Many live in poverty in rural Mississippi and all are recommended for camp from child protective services and social workers. Camp Friendship allows these children, often from difficult circumstances, the opportunity to be a kid and experience the wonder of nature and summer camp.

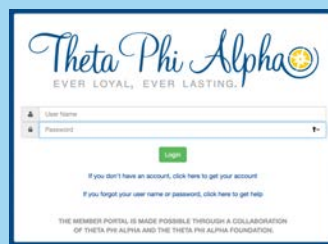
