Basic NVP-A Job Description



Serve as an Elected Officer to the Grand Council by the Convention Body with the main purpose to work towards ensuring that the alumnae members of Theta Phi Alpha have a strong experience and remain engaged with the overall organization.




General Duties of the NVP-A*

- Act as the liaison for Alumnae, Alumnae Associations and Clubs to the Grand Council;
- Issue letters to all members as they transition to the Alumnae Phase of membership;
- Respond to requests from Alumnae Panhellenic Associations;
- ➤ Issue Initiation Certificates (25th, 50th, & 75th);
- Issues thank you letters and gifts to National Volunteers during National Volunteer Week;
- Enlist sisters to assist in the formation/revitalization of new Alumnae Association/Club;
- Coordinate Alumnae Dues appeal process;
- Work with the Foundation to encourage donations to support organizational initiatives.

Important Things to Keep in Mind About the NVP-A Position

- You are voice of our alumnae! Work to understand the needs of all alumnae and work to support them through programming opportunities.
- Work with National Office Staff to accomplish strategic goals of the Grand Council and alumnae area
- You serves as a mentor and director to the volunteers in your area
- You keep the volunteers in your area updated on Theta Phi Alpha
- Maintain the systems that Theta Phi Alpha has established for Alumnae Programming (including files on Google Suite, Officer Portal, etc.)
- Attend NPC Alumnae Summit (odd years)

Sample Biennium



- ★ Quarterly Newsletter to Alumnae
 - September, January, April, June
- ★ Town Halls 3 times a year
 - October, February, May
- ★ Hold Alumnae Compass Connections Events
- ★ Full NVP-A Team Meetings 4-6 times a year
 - Smaller team meetings with Leads as needed.
- ★ Annual Dues Appeal
 - Initial letter in September; monthly media product for National Newsletters and social media posts; dues reminder in beginning of May
- ★ Set the Calendar of Due Dates for Biennium
- ★ Attend Grand Council Meetings and chats
- ★ Work with other NVP's on the Membership Experience

- Getting to continue to growing skill sets.
